

# COVID-19 Vaccination Information (Fall Vaccinations)

Takaoka City Health Promotion Section

## 1) Eligibility

You will be sent COVID-19 examination slips and vaccination coupons. Those who wish to get vaccinated should only do so after three months have passed since the day of their last COVID-19 vaccination; ensure you are informed and updated on current vaccine information before getting another vaccination.

**\*COVID-19 vaccinations for the fall will start on September 20<sup>th</sup>.**

## 2) Making an Appointment

The vaccinations starting on September 20<sup>th</sup> are designed to protect against the SARS-CoV-2 Omicron XBB 1.5 subvariant.

## 3) Important Information before Getting Vaccinated

a) Please fill in the necessary information on your examination slip with a ball pen.

b) Please bring the following to your appointment:

- i. **Examination slip and vaccination coupons** (do not detach).
- ii. **Photo ID** (Health Insurance Card, Driver's License, Residence Card, etc.)

c) If your body temperature exceeds 37.5°C or you do not feel well on the day, please contact the call center by phone.

d) If you have moved out of Takaoka City by the date of your appointment, you will no longer be able to use the vaccination coupons in Takaoka City (please inquire about the necessary procedures in your current municipality).

e) Regardless of the type of vaccine previously administered, you may choose between Pfizer and Moderna vaccine for the Omicron XBB 1.5 subvariant-specific booster.

## 4) Vaccination Certificate

The examination slip/vaccination coupon returned to you after vaccination is a document certifying you have been vaccinated. Please keep it in a safe place.
